



#### Directions from Greenville, Maine

- Head out of Greenville on the **Kokadjo/Lily Bay Road** towards Kokadjo. Greenville to Kokadjo is 18 miles on paved road. (25-30 minutes). Watch out for MOOSE in the road!
- You will enter Kokadjo after you see the big "Keep Maine Green" sign on the left, you will cross a small bridge and pass a store. Continue straight on the paved road through "town" (population not many)
- **Bear left** above Kokadjo where the paved road ends and dirt begins (**Baxter State Park Road**)
- After 1 mile **turn left** at the fork in the road where our camp sign is (*Spencer Pond Camps - Housekeeping Cabins - 12 miles*). This is the **Spencer Bay Road**. *There is an active logging operation currently in progress on this road. Please remember we have access to these roads, courtesy of the companies that own them, these are not public roads they are private. Please exercise prudence and understand the log trucks and loggers have the right of way! You may encounter a slight delay if the loggers are working near the road. They are very good about stopping their equipment and allowing you to pass through- usually within 5 minutes or less - please be patient. **Caution: at about 6 miles there is a large rock that is in the right lane of the road in the middle of a hill going up, it is painted orange/pink. Unless your vehicle has very high clearance - DO NOT DRIVE OVER IT - IT IS AN OIL PAN KILLER.***
- **Turn right** at 7.3 miles after you see our camp signs (small maroon sign before the turn, and metal sign at the corner.) Do not follow the signs to Spencer Bay. You will know you are on the right road if you cross a small bridge (after .7 miles), and then shortly after go through a big green steel gate (after 1.2 miles).
- At 3.3 miles you will go past a small gravel pit and cross another bridge. The road forks again here. **Stay Left** and follow our camp sign (Black with White reflective lettering). After bearing left, you will immediately cross another small bridge.
- Go .6 mile and **turn left** into our camp driveway at the big Maroon and White "Spencer Pond Camps Side"
- Follow the driveway down through the parking lot to the office - **you have ARRIVED!** You will be able to take your car down to your cabin to unload **after** checking in first. After the vehicle is unloaded it will be returned to the parking lot where it should stay for the remainder of your visit.
